- Newspapers/inserts
- Magazines, catalogs
- Paperboard, remove plastic liners (cereal, cracker boxes)
- Corrugated cardboard, flattened
- Phone books
- Brown paper bags
- Junk mail
- Office paper
- Shredded paper
- NO wax paper, plastic coated paper or plastic bags



Cans, Plastic, Glass

- Aluminum/tin/steel cans and lids
- Aluminum foil/pie plates
- Glass bottles/jars, all colors & sizes
- Plastic containers labeled - no styrofoam
- Juice/milk cartons
- NO plastic bags, please recycle at Hannaford's or Walmart
